According to the constitution, " Child laborers are those, who are aged below 14 years, and work in order to earn money. Normally, the labor undertaken by minor children is called " Child Labor".

To prohibit appointment of child laborers, the " Child labor prohibition and control act has been enacted. Industrialists, who violate this law, will have to mandatorily contribute Rs, 20,000 /- per child laborers to the welfare fund.

Article 24 of our constitution declares that employing children below 14 years for work is a cognizable offence.

Child marriage tradition is one of the major problems in our society. According to the law, the marriage that takes place between a boy of below 21 years and a girl who is below 18 years is child marriage.

Dowry is a custom associated with the Indian system of marriage, it is called as “Varadakshine” in Kannada. “Vara” means a boy of marriageable age.

Any kind of property, jewellery, or gift given to the bridegroom, at the time of marriage, either before or after the marriage is known as dowry

In order to legally eradicate the dowry system, the Central government enacted a “Prohibition act” in 1961. Those who violate this law are fined Rs\ 5000/ penalty or sent to the jail for 6 months.

When the fetus is that of a girl and the parents do not want a girl baby to be born. They kill in the womb itself. This is known as female feticide.

In order to stop the sex determination, tests of fortune through modern technology, the prohibitions of pre-natal gender determination test act was enacted in 1994.
