

## Some Considerations on Some Defects in Landscape Architecture and Design, Their Causes and Solutions

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### Abstract

We are talking about some shortcomings in landscape architecture design, that is, insufficiencies in urban planning of landscape architecture. On the insufficiency of specialists in landscape architecture, on the need to create departments or even institutes for landscape architecture.

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Everyone has a different answer to the question of what landscape architecture is, and everyone has a different concept. Therefore, we try to answer the question of what is landscape architecture from a scientific point of view.

Landscape architecture is considered a special direction of architectural creativity. We will not make a mistake when we say that plants serve as construction material here, and the world of plants, which we call construction material, is distinguished by its richness and diversity, its richness of colors, and the ability to shape it into any shape we want.

Through the experienced hands of landscape architects and flower gardeners, green plants and trees become urban planning material. Of course, whether it is a city or a park, whether it is a yard of an ordinary residential building, whether it is a kindergarten, or a street, we cannot imagine all of this without trees, flowers, and seedlings.

But there is a big difference between a landscape made by an expert, that is, a landscape architect, and a landscape made by an ordinary person. For example, let's take some yard landscapes in an ordinary Uzbek household. In the past, when we entered the courtyard of the house, we would certainly build a beautiful garden with basil, marigolds and fruit trees planted on the edge of the ditch.

But often, when we enter the yard, the branches of trees with fruit and fruitless trees, which are planted in different directions, grow like branches in the yard. Or in the streets of the neighborhood, on the roadsides, the trees are often neglected, their branches grow unorganized, and in some cases they are in a dry state. But in some houses and streets of the neighborhood, blue lawns, sidewalks, juniper trees are planted on the yard level, lictvinnitsa and pine trees, which are difficult to grow in our climate, are planted on the streets.

Why is that? There are many reasons for this.

For example:

1. The fact that our gardening art is lost and forgotten
2. Lack of —synthesis|| (harmonization) of modern landscape architecture with our traditional horticulture
3. Indifference of our people in this field is low level
4. Too little attention to landscape architecture

5. Literally lack or rather lack of skilled, talented, talented landscape architects
6. We believe that there is a lack or absence of a separate department of landscape architecture in schools of architecture.

It's true that any building, clothes, car, everything is not stable in the field of design, it changes over time. Such landscape architecture also changes over the years, of course.

Let's take our traditional landscape architecture as we mentioned above. For example: 55-60 years ago, today's Chilonzor was a large meadow, yards planted with fruit trees, and in the streets there was a path made of thin, various broken pieces of brick under the walls of the small houses, a brook about 0.5 meters wide and flowing from it then a 3-4 meter wide cart track. A landscape where willow trees are planted in an orderly manner along the edge of the stream, and between the willows are planted basil, black basil and sada basil. When you enter the courtyard, there is a small courtyard, in the middle of which is a mulberry tree, under which there is a well-watered sofa, about 3 meters away from the sofa, there is a stream of water, and white and red roses are growing on the side of the stream, and various types of basil are growing around the pool. The yard is in the shape of a square, with four different types of apricot trees in its four corners, thus ending the level of the yard, and the garden is filled with various types of grapes.

At this moment, the sayèx get off the cart and rest a little by the stream. They get drunk from the rose, basil, and gingelly planted with taste by the stream, drink a cup of fragrant green tea cooled in the stream, and sit in the cart again. 2

Of course, over time, cities, houses, and streets have changed, taking on a modern tone, and great changes have taken place. Especially after our country became independent, unprecedented changes took place. Modern residential buildings have also changed their landscape architecture. This is very good. But why did the fruit trees disappear on the streets of the neighborhood, why were the willows and willow trees not planted, why were the roses not visible on the streets. Why are only juniper trees being planted in many places?

We are a long way from saying that we should not plant juniper trees. Because juniper is an ecologically necessary tree as an air purifier. Why aren't fruit trees mixed with decorative trees and juniper trees? Why are the trees on the street and in the house not given a beautiful shape?

For example: let's take a simple plant "viva izgorot". It can even be used as a wall. It is easy to organize landscape architecture by giving it different shapes. There are trees and shrubs that can be shaped to create amazing landscape architecture. For example, a simple decorative mulberry tree can be used to create a beautifully shaped landscape. Even if you look carefully at the shape of the fruit trees, the fruit yield will be better.

As we all know, on both sides of most of the streets in Andijan, there are plots for growing grapes, and various grapes are grown in these plots. A person who sees this will have two different states. First, it is a good source of income. Second, it is an unusual landscape architecture that has not been done and seen anywhere.

Recently, it has become a custom to fill the courtyards of residential buildings, plant lawns, plant 4-6 fir trees and make a small pond in the middle. It would be good if these lawns grow well like in Europe, but in many cases it remains dry.

Our city of Tashkent is becoming more beautiful day by day. Skyscrapers are appearing wide and beautiful streets. But the shaping of trees in these streets has not yet been well established. However, there are trees and shrubs from which it is possible to create landscape architecture.

In conclusion, taking into account the above, more work should be done on landscape architecture and design. In order to make our republic even more beautiful, it is necessary to create more specialists in landscape architecture and design, create departments, faculties, and institutes that train landscape architects and designers.

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
