With a view to continuing developmental changes at a new historical stage, two new priority areas have been added to the Development Strategy. One of them is related to ensuring spiritual development, and the second is a new priority area based on Uzbekistan's response to global problems facing the world.¹

The New Uzbekistan Development Strategy envisages "further improving the mechanism of open dialogue with the people, expanding the practice of making important decisions taking into account public opinion, digitizing the process of considering appeals received by state bodies, and ensuring prompt and high-quality consideration of appeals. Most importantly, the "People's State" national program has been developed, which envisages the implementation of the idea that "the state must serve the people"²
